Hello, I hope you and your loved ones are doing well during this COVID-19 outbreak. I have some **new** important information that we **all** need to follow:

- Onondaga County Executive Ryan McMahon and Syracuse Mayor Ben Walsh are asking <u>EVERYONE</u> to <u>shelter in place</u> from TUESDAY APRIL 7TH until TUESDAY APRIL 21ST.
- That means **STAY AT HOME** unless absolutely necessary.
- If you must go out you can do so based on your birth year: if you were born on an <u>EVEN</u> year: example, 1960, 1962, 1964 etcetera you may go to the store for NECESSARY items <u>only</u> on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays or Sunday April 12th.
- If you were born on an <u>ODD</u> year: example. 1961, 1963, 1965 etcetera you may go to the store for NECESSARY items only on Mondays, Wednesdays or Fridays and Sunday April 19th.
- It is <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> to follow this order from the County Executive and the Mayor.
- We want everyone to be healthy and this will help the entire community.
- Continue to stay at least 6 feet from others.
- Wash your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds regularly.
- Clean regularly touched surfaces like doorknobs and table tops.
- Cough into your elbow or a tissue then wash hands again.
- DO NOT GO VISIT FRIENDS FOR THE NEXT TWO WEEKS.
- This virus has killed thousands of people because they are coming into close contact with people who can carry the virus and not show signs. **STAY AT HOME.**
- If you have a fever, cough or aches, call your doctor for advice, do NOT go to the ER. Thank you and stay safe.
