## Who is Eligible to Apply:

High School Seniors who live in Syracuse Housing Authority Public Housing or the Housing Choice Voucher Program (Section 8). Students must be enrolled in the fall for the academic year in an accredited and/or licensed technical school or accredited two (2) or four (4) year college or university in the United States. Students must be a United States Citizen.

Students must be presently living within SHA for one (1) full year prior to applying for scholarship funds.

## Requirements:

1. Student must live within Syracuse Housing Authority or Housing Choice Voucher Program
2. Student must be considered in good standing with Syracuse Housing Authority
3. GPA must be 2.7 (B)

## Key Dates:

- **Last Friday of May:** Deadline for submission of application, essay, transcript, proof of commitment letter, and 2 recommendations letters.
- **August:** Determination of award recipient.

## Award Amounts:

One Time Award of up to **\$500**.

Award may be used for any education related expense such as: tuition, fees, books, supplies, or transportation.

## Application Process:

- Each applicant must provide 250-500 word essay on how this scholarship can advance their career status.
- Submit application, essay and required documents by the last Friday of May to:

- Qualified applicants must participate in an interview.
- Awardees will be presented the scholarship in August.
