### About SHA's Annual 10K Basketball Tournament

Our tournament is unique in that, to participate, youth will attend training camps featuring local organizations and human service agencies promoting their various programming and resources.

The location of the training camp and tournament will be at Wilson Park, which will target youth living in public housing who are most at-risk of being victims or perpetrators of community violence. Partnering organizations will be provided the opportunity to incorporate mini-classes and training in the areas of financial empowerment, health and wellness, education, and job training programs at the training camps and tournament events. There will also be opportunities for local community-based organizations to table and perform outreach throughout the training camp and tournament, which will provide needed resources to at risk youth.

In addition to the tournament, during the halftime of the girls' championship game, SHA will again award the \$5K **Brexialee Torres Ortiz Memorial Scholarship**, a heartfelt tribute to the cherished memory of Brexialee Torres Ortiz, whose tragic departure due to gun violence on January 16, 2023, left a profound impact on SHA and all of our community. With the blessing of her family, we hope to assist a young SHA resident who wishes to continue their education in the same way that Brexi would have.

### **Youth Violence**

The City of Syracuse has witnessed an increase in youth violence, specifically, youth gun violence. According to the CDC, one evidenced based approach to preventing youth violence is, "connecting youth to caring adults and activities." Throughout the tournament, there are multiple opportunities to connect youth to caring adults (community-based organizations and community leaders) and activities (promoting basketball as an alternative to violence). The intention of this tournament and training camp are to introduce future SHA youth programs, enhance other city programs, and serve as a catalyst for additional community involvement or community violence intervention programming.

The main goal of this project is to engage with youth at risk of being victims of or perpetrating community violence, and connecting them with positive, caring adults in the community. This positive connection will be a catalyst for youth engagement throughout the City of Syracuse.

The secondary goal of this project is to bridge the gap with law enforcement, by facilitating positive interactions with law enforcement officers at the training camp and tournament. SHA plans to meet its secondary goal by recruiting first responders from the Syracuse Police Department to serve as coaches for the training camp and tournament.

### SHA's Community Involvement & Impact

The Syracuse Housing Authority's Resident Support Services (RSS) Department conducts outreach and engagement efforts to youth and families living in SHA properties who are often at risk of perpetrating or being victims of violence. Residents have requested to continue this tournament annually. We have also received requests for an increase in youth programming as residents have noted a decrease in negative behaviors in youth when there are positive program alternatives. SHA hopes to prevent community violence in youth residents as a result of the \$10k Tournament, in addition to connecting youth to community-based organizations funded to provide structure, healthy coping skills, and educational programming.


